House by Lake Biel

Located on a gentle slope on the southern shore of Lake Biel, this new construction was built on the site of an old 19th-century romantic garden that once belonged to a villa that no longer exists today. The living room and kitchen are housed on the ground floor with direct contact to the outside. A small forest and a lake created from a natural source are located to the east, while to the west views open out onto the garden with its lush vegetation and lake in the background. On the first floor two sculptural volumes containing two bathrooms modulate the large area and a curtain system created a sleeping area and two zones for work and meditation. The ground floor is characterized by the use of exposed concrete and transparency, while this floor is entirely made of wood and suggests and is more private in nature.
